**PROJECT: DELAWARE SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY (DSWA) SANDTOWN FACILITY
LEACHATE TRANSMISSION SYSTEM**

Notice is hereby given that the Kent County Department of Public Works will accept Statements of Qualifications from engineering firms for the above project until 2:00 p.m., Friday, February 17, 2012 at the Kent County Administrative Complex, 555 Bay Road, Dover, Delaware 19901.

Project design will include, but is not limited to:

- Specialized leachate pump station and controls constructed at the DSWA Sandtown Landfill.
- Approximately 48,000 LF of small diameter force main, open-cut and/or trenchless installation, between Sandtown Landfill and the Town of Felton, primarily via Sandtown Road and Route 12.
- Terminal leachate discharge point.

Award of the contract will be based on a competitive ranking. All submittals must address, at a minimum, the following criteria:

- A. Reputation and expertise of the firm.
- B. Staffing capacity to meet expected work load.
- C. Location of office where work will be performed.
- D. Demonstrated ability in previous projects.
- E. Familiarity with Public Works projects / standards.
- F. Hourly rate schedule.
- G. SF 254 (as applicable to specific discipline)

The County reserves the right to award a contract to a respondent in the best interests of the County or to decide not to award any contract at all. All prices, terms, and conditions contained in the statement will remain fixed and valid for the duration of the project.

Submittals should be limited to five (5) pages, in addition to the SF 254 or equivalent.
