Kent County Department of Public Works Seeks Professional Engineering Services

Dover, Del. - Kent County Levy Court, Department of Public Works is seeking Professional Engineering Services through a Request For Qualifications (RFQ) to develop a Long Range Wastewater Master Plan assessing the wastewater needs of Kent County, Delaware for a 20-year period. Kent County's wastewater collection, conveyance and treatment system serves the residents and businesses of Kent County and small portions of the adjacent counties. Using the current plan as a starting point, the new plan will provide the basis of the path forward for the future.
