### **Kent County Department of Public Safety Sponsors 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Thanksgiving Food Drive**

That’s why on Wednesday, November 15, 2017 food donations are being collected for the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual “Pack the Paramedic Truck” Thanksgiving Food Drive. The collection site is Redners Warehouse Markets, 25 Greentree Drive, Dover, Delaware from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Donations assist the Food Bank of Delaware. “Last year we collected 2,102 pounds of food for individuals who find themselves in need,” said Assistant Director of Public Safety, Cindy Grygo. A paramedic truck will be weighed before and after the food drive; and after the truck is packed, donations will be delivered to the food bank the following morning.

Kent Countians may donate foods such as: canned vegetables, cranberry sauce, evaporated milk, canned pumpkin, canned fruit, corn muffin mix, mashed potatoes, gravy or any other non-perishable item that will ensure a good Thanksgiving meal for a needy family.
