Kent County Parks and Recreation Summer Day Camp

Dover, Del. – Kent County Division of Parks and Recreation is accepting applications for Summer Day Camp for youth six to 12 years of age. Summer Day Camp starts the week of June 18, and will continue through August 10, 2018. at W. Reily Brown Elementary School, 360 Webbs Lane in Dover.

From 7:30 a.m. until 5:30 p.m., campers will be engaged in activities including arts and crafts, table games, sports, nature activities, and special visitors. Children should bring their lunch, drink and snacks each day.

The fee for the eight-week program is \$80 per week per child, with the exception of the week of July 2 where the fee is reduced to \$64 due to the 4th of July Holiday. Registration may be made for one week, two weeks, or the full eight weeks, however, payment must be made in advance of attendance. Because space is limited to 50 campers per week, enrollments are being accepted in the order in which they are received with full payment.
