**Fee Schedule**  
**Effective July 1, 2019 per FY2020 Budget Ordinance 19-04**

**Charge for Sanitary Sewer/Utility Plan Reviews:** The charge for services to review a set of plans and transmit the approval letter necessary for DNREC to issue the “Wastewater Construction Permit” shall be \$1,100/project or \$27/EDU, whichever is less. Payment is due at the time of initial plan submittal.

**Charge for Private Street Plan Reviews:** The charge for services to review a set of plans and transmit the engineering approval letter required by the Kent County Planning Services Division for private streets shall be \$30/lot. Payment is due at the time of the initial plan submittal.

**Sanitary Sewer District (SSD) Creation/Extension:** The charge for services to prepare a district extension or the creation of a new district shall be \$325 per EDU up to a maximum of \$4,700. This charge shall include the preparation of a technical feasibility study (TFS). Payment is due at the time of request. An additional fee of \$400 shall be charged for publication of the public notice(s). Payment is due at the time of request.

**Contract User Creation/Revision:** The charge to prepare a new contract user agreement or to revise an existing one shall be \$4,000. This charge shall include the preparation of a TFS. Municipal and Federal contract users are exempt from this charge. Payment is due at the time of request.

**Sanitary Sewer Infrastructure Testing/Inspection Services:** The charge to perform testing and/or inspection services shall be \$140/EDU. Projects requiring such services shall be defined as any project containing sewer infrastructure discharging to the Kent County Regional Sewer System. Payment is due at the time of plan approval.

**Private Street Testing/Inspection Services:** The charge to perform testing and/or inspection services for private streets shall be \$140/lot. Projects requiring such services shall be as defined in the Kent County Code, Chapter 187, Subdivision and Land Development. Payment is due at the time of plan approval.

**Main Sewer Video Inspection Fee:** A fee of \$1.30 per lineal foot, but not more than \$1,300/day, shall be charged for conducting a video inspection of all new main sanitary sewers prior to final acceptance of the sewers, or the developer may choose to utilize the services of an outside contractor and submit the inspection to digital format. Payment is due at the time of plan approval.

**Sewer Account Modification Charge:** A \$600 fee shall be assessed for creating a new individual sewer account for structures that had previously been assessed an improvement or expansion fee and subsequently billed as a part of a multi-structure account. Payment is due at the time of request.

**Septage Hauler Discharge Rate:**

Septage:	\$61.92/1000 gallons
Grease:	\$75.00/1000 gallons (A minimum of 75% per load must originate from Kent County food service facilities)

**Environmental Permit Applicant Fees:** Payment for all application fees shall occur at the time the application is submitted.

- (1) **Significant Industrial User (SIU):** A fee of \$3,250 shall be charged for a new SIU permit, or a modification to or the renewal of an existing 5-year SIU permit.
- (2) **Septage and/or Grease Waste Hauler:** An annual fee of \$125 per truck shall be charged for a permit to haul septage and/or grease wastes.
- (3) **Oil and Grease Interceptors/Traps:** A tri-annual permit to operate an oil and grease interceptor or a trap requires the following application fees:

Owners with 100 or less gallons of total trap/interceptor volume in one FSF	No Charge for that FSF
Owner with 1 FSF and >100 gallons of total trap/interceptor volume	\$300
Owners with 2 to 5 FSF's and >100 gallons of total trap/interceptor volume	\$250/facility
Owners with 6 or more FSF's and >100 gallons of total trap/interceptor volume	\$200/facility

- (4) **The Grease Interceptor/Trap re-inspection Fee:** Fee shall be \$100 per re-inspection.
- (5) **Sewer Connection Permit Fees:** The various sewerage permits shall be valid for (12) months after receipt of payment by the Department of Public Works. After said time period they shall become null and void. The fees are as detailed below.
  - (A) *Commercial*        \$325
  - (B) *Residential*        \$85
  - (C) *Institutional*       \$325
- (6) **Administrative Fee:** A fee of \$100 shall be charged for each refund request of either or both sanitary sewer impact fees processed by staff to cover associated personnel costs. The fee shall be paid at the time the refund request is submitted.
- (7) Fees contained within this table shall be reviewed at least once every two years by the Department of Public Works and any recommendations for change shall be submitted to the Sewer Advisory Board and Levy Court for consideration.
