### Pre-Census Day Sit-in at Kent County Public Library, March 28

**Dover, Del.** – Census Day is April 1, 2020. Kent County residents have an opportunity to take advantage of Kent County Public Library's outstanding wi-fi connection and internet stations to fill out the online forms for the [2020 U.S. Census](#). Census Forms will be mailed to Delaware residents March 12 through March 22. On Saturday, March 28, 2020 Kent County Library will be available between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m., for a 'Census Sit-In' to encourage citizens to complete their forms on-line. Bring your own electronic device – or use one of 18 state of the art workstations! It's fast and free with your library card. If you don't have a library card, staff will be available to help set one up. Residents can also apply for an online library card at [lib.de.us](http://lib.de.us).
