Levy Court Commissioners Presents Medal of Honor

Dover, Del. – Levy Court Commissioners presented a Medal of Honor to Carolyn Fredericks of the Modern Maturity Center for her dedication and advocacy on behalf of older adults. She started at the Modern Maturity Center as a volunteer in 1972 and today is President/CEO of the non-profit.

Over the years, Ms. Fredericks has increased programs and services, and transformed the Center into the largest senior Center in Delaware. She has also collaborated with other stakeholders to help get the Delaware Senior Trust Fund Bill, which established a way for funding services for the senior population, and secured additional funding for the Meals on Wheels nutrition program, as well.

The Medal of Honor is Kent County Levy Court's highest honor. This was the first medal presentation since September, 2018.
